Clinical Psychologist is the journal of the Australian Psychological Society's College of Clinical Psychologists. The journal covers a range of topics of broad general relevance to psychologists working in clinical and health settings, including assessment and treatment of psychopathology as well as commentary on theoretical, social and cultural issues and applied therapies across the lifespan. The aim is to publish high quality peer-reviewed articles within this broad scope.

Clinical Psychologist publishes state of the art reviews, research papers, brief reports, and clinical case studies. Commentaries on matters of consequence to clinical psychologists, including techniques and approaches in psychological practice, professional development issues, and professional and public policy issues are also published. A section for student publications is designed to showcase the work of emerging researchers in the field.

To be reviewed for possible publication in this journal all authors must follow the instructions below and submissions should be made online at the Manuscript Central site for Australian Psychological Society journals to facilitate rapid accessibility of work to the readers. New users should first create an account. Once a user is logged onto the site submissions should be made via the Author Centre.
